Which actions are taken and what results do they bring?

- Development of Competence Gap Detector: a tool combining online questionnaires and interviews to identify skill gaps in personal, civic, and entrepreneurial competences.
- Training of 30 educators and social workers to support young women with migrant background.
- Migrant girls learning groups develop and manage micro projects on integration and present the results to policy-makers in Brussels
- Design of a 75h training programme with 15 e-learning modules based on the 3 key competences.
- Production and publication of a Policy Paper with key findings & recommendations.
